Advances in Specialty Practice

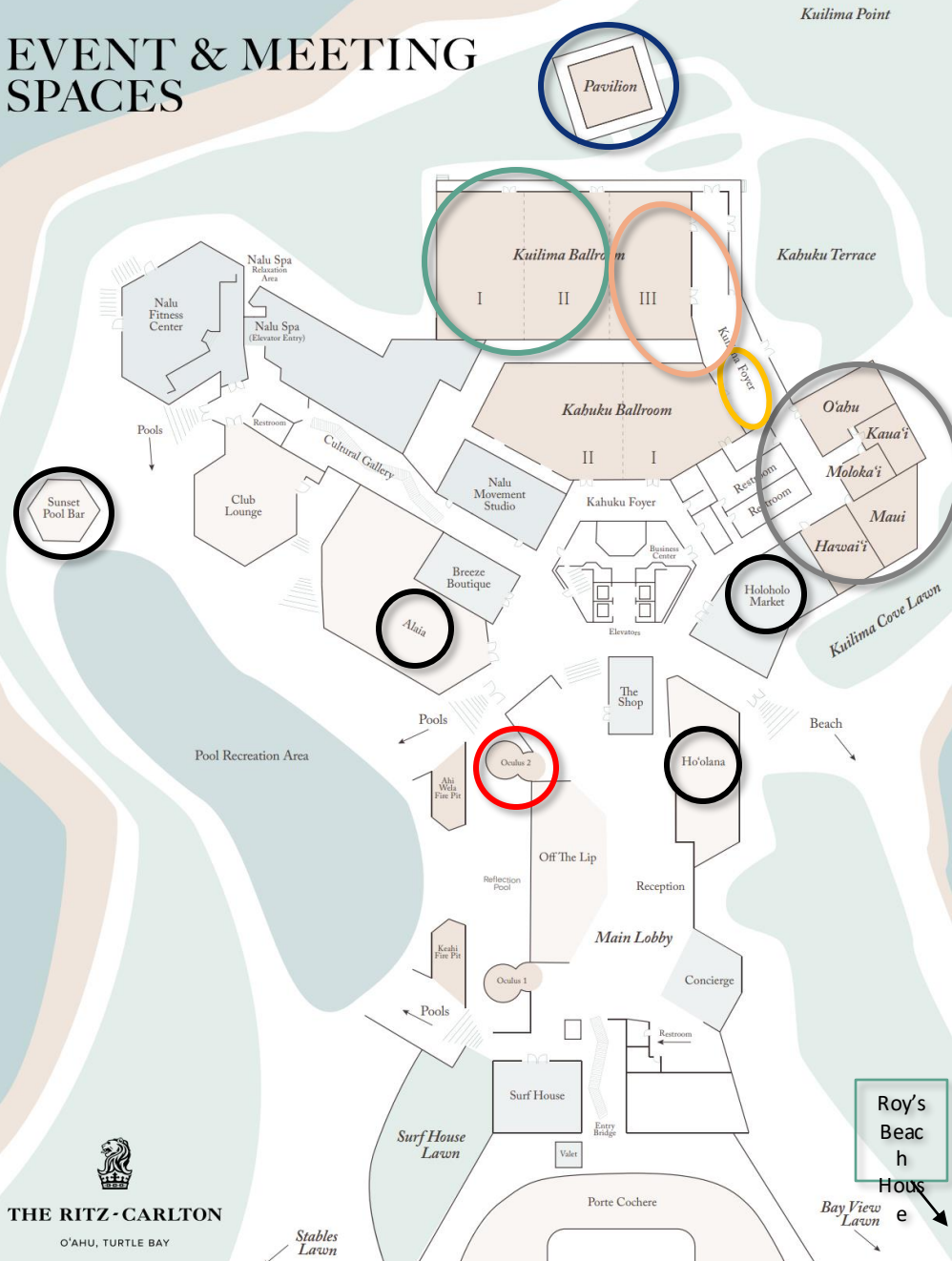

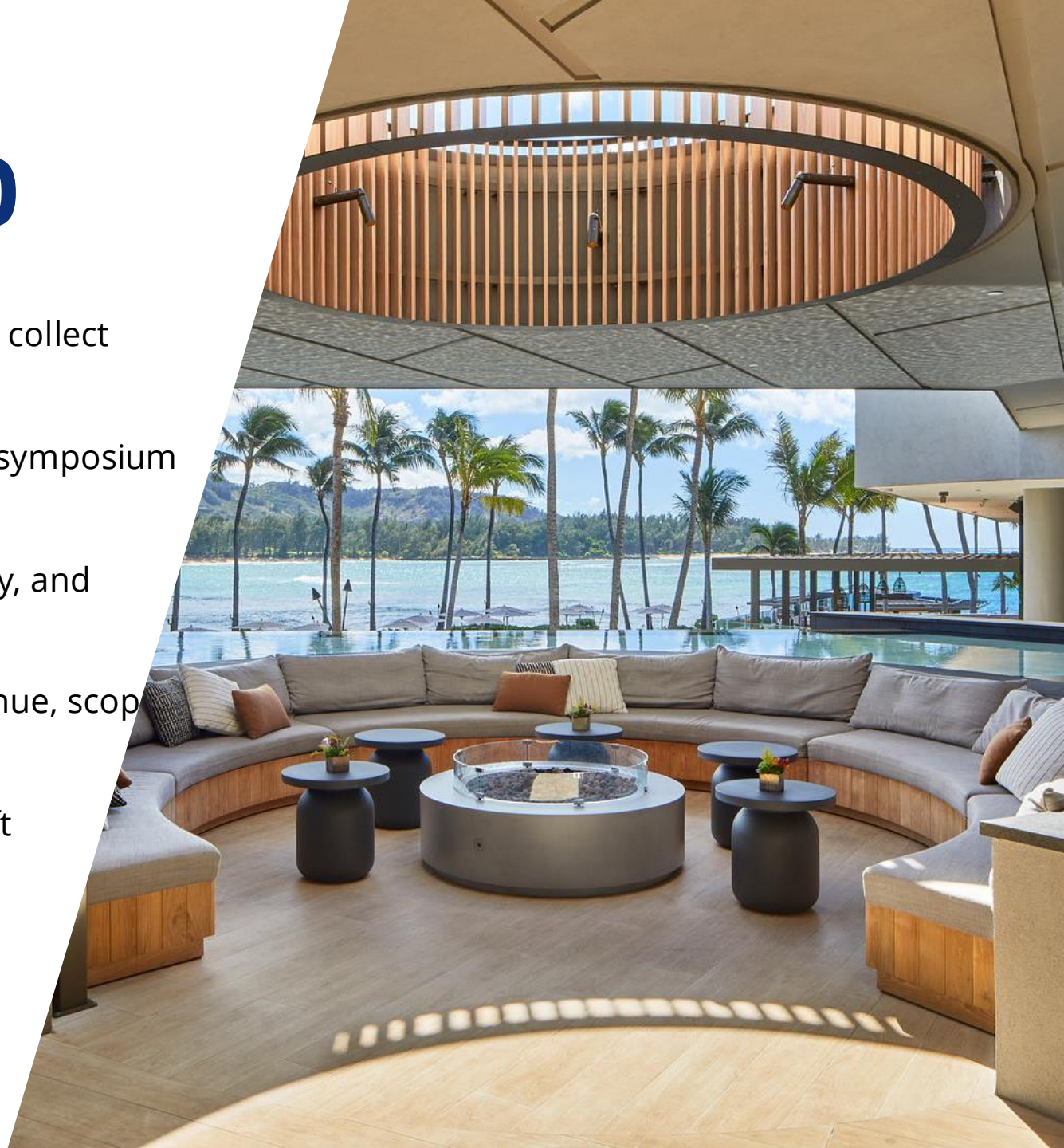

ACCME's Standards

- (16) AMA PRA Category 1 credit hours are issued by Cedars Sinai
- Premier Platinum & Platinum Exhibitors participating in the "Innovation Summit" must comply with the following CME standards:
- **3.2 Exclude owners or employees of ineligible companies:** Review the information about financial relationships to identify individuals who are owners or employees of ineligible companies.
